

## Privacy policy for applications within KIT-AUTH cooperation

The following explanations contain information on the processing of your personal data in accordance with Art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter: GDPR).

We collect and process your personal data for the execution and administration of the application. If the data is used for evaluation and quality assurance measures, this is done exclusively in anonymous form.

Within KIT, the data will only be forwarded to the offices responsible for the implementation and processing of the application, in particular to the Business Units Graduate School for Climate and Environment (GRACE), Legal Affairs (RECHT), Financial Management (FIMA), Human Resources (PSE), the office for International Affairs (INTL) and to the selection committee consisting of members from KIT and the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH).
